

UKCPA LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The UKCPA invites nominations for their Lifetime Achievement Award.

The United Kingdom Clinical Pharmacy Association is proud to invite nominations for the second UKCPA Lifetime Achievement Award, which aims to recognise outstanding contributions to clinical pharmacy practice.

The adjudication panel will be particularly keen to reward achievements in developing and promoting clinical pharmacy, innovation, research and development, publication and dissemination of good practice, and recognition by their peers. As it is a Lifetime Achievement Award, achievements should be over a period of time.

Nominees should be proposed and seconded by members of the UKCPA. Nominations should detail the nominee's name and the reasons for the nomination in no more than 500 words. Nominees do not need to be members of the Association.

All nominations should be submitted to the UKCPA office for consideration by **30th September 2009**.

Winners will be notified by the Chair of UKCPA and invited to attend the Association's Autumn Residential Symposium as a guest of the UKCPA.

An award will not necessarily be given every year; it is up to the discretion of the UKCPA adjudicating team whether any of the nominees should receive the award.

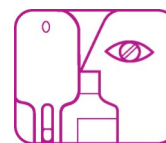
It is proposed that the winner will make a short acceptance speech highlighting their experiences and inspiring pharmacists to achieve in their careers during the presentation of the award at the Saturday night conference dinner.

The UKCPA was delighted to award their first Lifetime Achievement Award on 22nd November 2008 to Chris Barrett, a key pioneer of clinical pharmacy in the UK. He encouraged pharmacists to work outside the dispensary; developing one of the first formularies and establishing one of the first Drug & Therapeutic Committees; and he supported and developed his staff and colleagues to deliver services that benefit patients. Chris was perceptive of the need to bring together the strengths of practice and academia and he encouraged joint developments and established joint appointments, particularly with the London School of Pharmacy for his pioneering work and outstanding contribution to Pharmacy.
